## **Preface**

It is difficult to deny the existence of Flying Saucers (UFOs) even today while the countries, like, America, Russia and Australia are enriched with the experiences of watching the flying saucers in their various shapes. A solid proof of the presence of the UFOs has been recorded by the radars of the air forces of these countries. Not only this, more than two millions of people have claimed about watching the UFOs from close quarters, taking their photographs and publishing them in the newspapers and magazines, giving interviews and getting them recorded at their nearest centers. All this proves that the Earth and its people has always been the centre for research studies by the highly developed bodies in the scientific system of the solar family. All this has been happening with the Earth for past 50 years. The UFOs have been playing the game of hide and seek with the humans on the Earth. They have been evading our friendship or any contact with us for all these years. After all, what must be the reason behind it?

Why do they not want our company or friendship or any relationship, whatsoever? There must be some definite cause, and this science fiction, therefore, proceeds further in quest of the same.

This fiction in its later part enters the domain of timelessness. If the travelers of unidentified flying objects have arrived here after scaling a number of light-years, or even if we become able to float in the space with the speed of light, say, after thousands of years, and perchance such means are developed, perhaps our age or life span will fall short of scaling such a distant travel. And, to cross this hurdle, and to escape the friction of light-years, it will be necessary for the space-travelers to get themselves set up in the timelessness.

The explanation for timelessness in this story is that the time never passes for an individual who is beyond the scope of the feel of the time. The unbalanced friction with motion lands on the mind, the brain and the body. The feel of ageing grows thereby. The rarest phenomenon of timelessness can occur only when a time with the motion on physical level remains perfectly compatible, accurate,

balanced and nature-oriented. Such a state is beyond the passage of time, or the feel of time. Such a state can be attained by breaking both the walls of consciousness and unconsciousness, or by assimilating them into one. An individual who attains such a state gets cent per cent established in the level of a special consciousness of the present moment. The timelessness can be practiced through falling into a meditative mood, and whose aim is to set the man into the present moment of time, both physically and mentally, irrespective of his age which he belonged to, whether present or time immemorial in the past.

The space-traveler in the present time cannot be dangerous to any one and any time. His nature must be like that of our great saints and ascetics, and may be perhaps like that of Buddha or Mahavir. One who gets established in a fixed mind, and lives above the emotions, can never be cruel or violent, rather he would be an ocean of infinite kindness, pity and friendship.

An attempt to construct a new theory based on the timelessness and its effect has been made in this science fiction that any traveler of flying saucer or space, who

lands on the Earth after scaling several light-speeds, cannot be cruel or violent by nature. This attempt was necessary, for no such attempt has been ever made in any other science fiction, so far. Ordinarily, in other fictional works, the creatures living on outer planets or stars have been labeled as cruel and violent. But this fiction overrules their presumption. So far as the timelessness is concerned, an attempt to explain the theory has been made in a new manner in this fiction. In this, it is believed that every object or particle is required to create the gravitational pull in a needed quantity, in proportion to its density, so that it may remain in its motion. In the same plane if the average gravitational pull of man and the machine is comparatively equal, quite accurate, the incident of timelessness is bound to occur. The loss of comparatively most balanced energy has been considered timelessness, and free of the bounds of time. Such a space traveler is definitely bound to be a long living creature, and will also be embodied with unparallel qualities and powers. It is because the man established in the present time learns to make use of more than half of his

brain. It is also traceable in the state of meditative mood or meditation.

But, there crops up one more question whether the same meditative course with perfect timing, which is used for getting set into timelessness, for longevity as well as escaping the friction of light-speed, was used for space travel, say, five to ten thousand years ago. Certainly, otherwise such a developed state of meditation practiced in ancient days would not have entered the life of India, without any purpose. Its origin can well be traced in religious scriptures as to how the rishis and munis by the power of their meditation used to appease the gods and goddesses and aspire for the pleasures of heavens. All those sages were skilled in the cosmic science by virtue of their meditative power. Though the discoverer of the meditative power or the need to discover to such a unique quality is not yet known, it merely appears a charismatic phenomenon in the human life, and man then made use of his charismatic capacity to achieve the religious goals. Yet, it seems to be starting during the time of Buddha and Mahavir.

However, above observation is not the centre of this science fiction. In this fiction, the focus is not devastating effect of gravitational pull developed on the human-brain, which has been presented in a new manner, creating a warning for the future. It is known to all that the magnet in gravitational pull affects the human-brain. Its solid proof is occurrence of surrounding phenomena in abundance on the night of full moon and rise in the suicidal incidents. It proves that the dynamic energy-waves in the brain are influenced by the magnetic effect of the gravitational pull.

This effect can be described in detail as follows -- All know that it is only the human life, amongst all other creatures in the world, which is full of complexities of outer world, and the human brain can be utilized for storing of various types of information while other creatures lack this faculty.

The human-brain is required to remember innumerable information with complexities, and he applies them for functioning of its body and the controlling it. A divisive line can be drawn from here, that the brain which is made for controlling and functioning of complexities of the body,

can also be deployed for bearing the complexities of the outer world.

As this process is constant, and whenever the pressure imbalances, the consumption of energy in the brain increases, creating uncontrolled electrical waves as a natural phenomenon. This the reason for man's becoming emotional and unbalanced in his mental tendencies. This effect increases more when the entire human race is seen infected by the cut-throat competition. In fact, it is quite natural for any civilization in its zenith to get spoilt in mental balance or to become unnatural and cruel or violent. Now, according to the scientists, such madness is recorded in the man generation after generation. In a sense, man has been receiving unbalanced mentality in succession from his ancestors. As a result, all instincts to commit violence, excitement and unnatural tendencies reduced the competence of the brain which then automatically loses the control on its electrical waves. And, in case the clouds of gravitational pull cover the Sun in the state of man's semi-madness, its devastating impact is bound to fall on human brain.



In such a case, the pressure of uncontrolled electrical waves will build on the human brain, and then more heat in the brain will secret, causing his easy death. In this way, the entire human race may perish. But, before the man reaches that state, he may become so much excited and violent that quarreled among his own men, he will die. Such a situation will invite the use of atomic weapons and a great destruction will take place.

May be, the Nature will pave the way for the total annihilation of the cruel, the unnatural and the unbalanced creatures from this Earth. It must have been the deciding factor even for the elimination of dinosaurs, about six billion years ago. This fiction gathers ample evidence in support of these principles and leads to the conclusion.

If we take into account the great upheaval on the crust of the Earth, and link them with Sun-borne gravitational pull or 'darker aspects', it appears that after every five thousand and seven thousand years, the black spots of gravitational pull must be occurring around the Sun. May be, that change must have led to the battle of Mahabharat, or to which the most developed civilization of Harrappa

and Mohen-jo-daro or pyramid culture of Egypt must have succumbed. It also must have been the cause of total elimination of the dinosaurs.

Besides, in this fiction, an attempt has been made to re-analyze the material science, which will help in understanding the theory of timelessness as discussed in the science fiction. It is to prove that the loss of matter is directly related to the motion and the radiation caused by the gravitational pull, emanation of the gravitation and its continuity in the beginning, in the middle and in the end, a perpetual emanation. A new approach has been made herein about the Sun and its solar family, a newer concept has been developed about the living world. It was the need of the hour to bring out such a fictional work.

If any one wants to further explore with some motive for a long time, it is necessary for him to know all about the Nature. The details supplied about the solar family in a new dimension here will prove a greater help to the readers.

The protagonist of the fiction, touching the end of his mission, marches ahead. The story might be fictitious, but the facts are not far off from their realities. It demanded a

While passing through the area of gravitational pull maximum equipment of UFO become active, and as several precautions are to be observed, the spacemen also remain very active and cautious.

Some of their companions were getting ready to launch the small flying saucers kept in the big flying saucer, and they were placing the caps of small open upside-down plates on the head of the saucer and laying down the empty pipes of enervated cells in the belly of the saucer. The small flying saucer reaching close to the Sun derives its heat into the upside-down plate and transfers the same heat into electrical energy which then gets accumulated in the empty cells.

It soon became clear that none of the objects caught in sight possessed any element of life on them. Hearing it, all became normal, for the Solar family without any life was of no use to them. At the most, they could utilize it as a

temporary station for their sojourn. Moreover, they had no need to study the dust and sand particles or stones of solar family, as its study was millions of years old and it was common phenomenon, and therefore, the study bore no significance for them.

Their aim was to trace the lives just like them, and change the notion about rarity of these lives and also enrich their own knowledge thereby. The millions of sensitive equipment installed in all the five UFOs were actively recording information about various planets, stars and satellites and were passing the only useful and important information to their Commander. The Commander was engrossed in hearing eighteen types of sound coming together, and in the meantime he was intermittently passing necessary instructions to the group leaders of all the five UFOs.

The next moment, the Commander gave orders to all group leaders of the UFOs to set themselves at such a distance from the Earth so that they could retaliate any attack on them from the Earth, and could easily change their positions. All the giant UFOs started returning to their earlier position. They did not find satellite on their way or even nearby placed and accordingly they intimated their Commander. In a sense, they were free from the fear of satellites, but their faces still bore the terror. They were so terrified that for a while they thought as if they were caught in an attack from atom bomb.

A second ago, they had experienced certain dangerous waves striking their saucers, and they were resembling the waves which usually emanated from an atomic explosion. In fact, it was an atomic explosion made from the Earth into the air. They realized this fact after some time, and so, they were terror-struck for a while. They, raising their hands up in the air, thanked God as if they were saved from some big mishap. For a while they thought as if they had become the target of the atom bomb. Now, they were safe at some distance from the Earth.

The explosion from the Earth had created disbelief in them about the activities of the creatures of the Earth. They were now more careful about any such danger to them from the living creatures of the Earth. For a while, they thought that their flying saucers had sunk into the sand-bed without reaching the destination. They were perplexed. The Commander, soon after this incident, sent an unmanned small flying saucer towards the Earth. This small flying object was to collect the joint capacity of all types of radio active explosions and also their locations on the Earth.

All the five UFOs became connected to one another, and all companions went into the chamber of the Commander. Now they were to decide their further course of action to analyze their doubts about the creatures on the Earth and the possible way to form friendship with them. All the eight screens in the chamber of the commander were cleared for the information receivable from the small flying object.

Within some time, the piles of information gathered on the screens. Having read it, they became perplexed. They were unable to understand whether the information was about the so-called most developed creature on the Earth or about the real incarnation of Death. UFO men had to remark that the creature on the Earth seemed so over ambitious that he should like to see such a vast Sun revolve around him. Others agreed with what one of them had remarked. Then, some of them showed to others two such spots which were close to each other, and were looking destroyed by the atom bomb.

One of them indicating towards the spots, said, both the spots must have been occupied by the living creatures and they, burning with hysteria of anger, must have launched their nuclear weapon on each other just to kill, and in this way, both the towns on Earth must have got destroyed. Brooding over the problem and exchanging the views of his companions, the Commander adjourned the meeting for a while, commenting that the living creatures on the Earth appeared to be extremely violent and so they were bound to be cunningly mean as well, yet they should know their nature and behaviour before entering into friendship with them.

They then decided to study man's behaviour on the Earth and all his activities. The Commander then orders that the team-mates must divide in two parts in order to

study the nature of living creatures of the Earth. One group was to study the nature of human species while the other was to study all other creatures and their species. They had maintained a safe distance from the Earth and remained watchful about any attack launched from the creatures of the Earth. They then started going by their decision.

And soon, the commander's order was implemented. The entire group divided in two parts and started studying about the creatures of the Earth. They were utilizing the unmanned small flying saucer which was sent to the orbit of the Earth in the form of an artificial satellite and was moving round it. Gradually the small flying object tearing apart the atmosphere of the Earth started collecting the important information.

During their brief study, the UFO men watched the Earth from very close quarters and they found it more beautiful. They had become so much fascinated to the Earth, they had started becoming emotional and subdued by the earthly desires. The enchanting beauty of the Earth had penetrated into the armor of 'timelessness' which was their shield for survival.

A medical professional in the team became worried over such development and he passed information to the commander. He forecast the differences that might crop up among the members of the study teams, and therefore, a due precaution was needed. The Commander for a while was shocked to hear all this, but he could realize that his team mates would not fall sick without surfacing of the differences and without damaging the 'timelessness'. He also knew that breeding of sickness in the space might cause a great danger to their lives.

He took the advice of the medical professional seriously who directed him to keep a constant watch on the health of the team mates. He himself also started searching for the cause of this sickness so that he might get rid of personal dissatisfaction. It was perhaps the first ever experience when he had to face the difference of opinions of his team mates.

After the study of the human creatures was complete, the Commander summoned his team mates into his cabin where they had to discuss the aspects of friendship and its study. The Commander had to take the one-sided decision

which was free from any objection from his team mates and which was beyond the scope of any challenge to his authority.

To his team mates who had assembled in his cabin with their recorded cassettes and other preparations, the Commander addressed them saying, “You all know, the cruelty of the living creatures of the Earth during our first meet with them raised two vital questions before us, and both the questions were linked with our mission, and therefore we should take proper decision after deep pondering over each aspect of the issue. by nature. Such a race may turn dangerous if any friendship is formed, and all our dreams for the great mission are likely to be broken due to it. Relying on such creatures would mean showing negligence towards the great aim. And, at no cost we would allow our years-long efforts towards the great aim collapse by involving menfolk of the Earth, and so, the idea of friendship with men on the Earth will have to be dropped for ever.”

He further said, “Now, we should take care of their study rather than making friendship with them. You all have seen almost all the planets during your short time study. You found that the creatures of the Earth were enriched with so many things which we could not think of. Even our own world of origin was not ever enriched with the varieties of species the Earth possessed. And, after all, all these species are the experimental combination of different chemical, physical and mathematical principles, and our own scientific knowledge will become enriched if we analyze the operative principle of these elements in the combination and examine their unique coordination within themselves. The Solar family, which is close to us, bears its

own significance, and while our own world of origin must be counting its last breaths, a large part of our own civilization might be forced to settle on the Earth before its explosion or death occurs. And therefore, its study is important to us. Earlier, we had thought of making friendship with the creatures of the Earth so that we could reach our mission peacefully in less time frame. But as the circumstances have become adverse, we have not only to save ourselves from their friendship but also from their enmity. We must therefore complete our study by escaping their sight, or else they will forget their fights among themselves and start fighting against us with a war-like situation. They might hunt for us in the entire solar family and a new race of arms might open. Therefore, we will have to save ourselves from the unnecessary trouble from their sight during our study. This might be a very difficult task because the entire Earth is infested with them, but the task is not at all impossible too. So, bear in mind to protect yourselves from their sight.” Saying these words, the Commander kept quiet, perhaps to give chance to his companions to react to whatever was spoken by him.

Finding an opportunity to express himself, one of the team mates, named, Huhi, raised a volley of questions on his Commander, “Do you think that such a heaven-like beautiful Earth will remain safe after the terrific race of destructive weapons and radioactivity caused by them ? Whether the life on the Earth will be unsafe ? Whether our own dying civilization will ever get a chance to live on such a beautiful place, called Earth ? Whether our civilization will be able to survive on the debris of ashes ? Whether the civilization on Earth will ever believe in our study ? Do you think the living creatures will be responsible for the destruction of living planet ?” and he became quiet.

There was a resentment in his tone. All listeners were stunned for a while, perhaps they had never heard such a sharp tone before. All others thought that he was casting a challenge to the words of their Commander. The Commander was not in a position to take a decision, and finding inconsistency in the assertion of Huhi, he asked Huhi to complete his point of view. Huhi then handed a

cassette to his companion and it was displayed on a big screen.

All were watching the display. Huhi was also watching it. Actually, he had gathered in the cassette the snaps of his choice and he wanted to explain his point of view through them. Beautiful but soundless scenes of the Earth were appearing on the screen. He wanted to explain that save human beings all living creatures of the Earth, including animals and birds, even those living in water and land, all maintain a rapport with the Nature, and none of them has any hunger of accumulating or hoarding for the future.

There appeared on the screen the soldiers doing drills and parading, etc, and a large display of their weapons and armaments, and also two maps of the Earth attacked by nuclear warheads with radioactivity and other types of explosions which were reflected by black patches, all for a while noticeable, and they suddenly disappeared.

All present in the cabin withdrew in their chairs and started looking at one another, but Huhi was still restless as if he wanted to express something more or as if some



volcano within him wanted to erupt. Perhaps, he wanted to prove that the creatures on the Earth, as appeared through their picture on the screen, were not only violent and cruel but also they could take the beautiful Earth to a great ruin.

This was his perplexity, difference of opinions with others and a discontentment, all visible in his eyes. His protruding round eye-balls were looking like a jostling boat on the waves during a storm, although his spinal cord was uprightly aligned with the neck, for he was leading his ten sick companions.

Keeping quiet for some time, he again looked into the eyes of the Commander and said with confidence, "I want that we all should help the living planet, the Earth with its living creatures, for its beauty is excellent and rare as well. What I feel is that the living creature, the man, on one hand, is creating imbalance in the natural resources by exploiting them in his interest, and on the other, he is making huge piles of the deadly armaments which, when used jointly, can turn this planet into ashes. In this way, he is taking this planet to great destruction, rather he has already created such a situation that the existence of all

sorts of creature living on it is in danger. You all have seen in your brief study as to how dangerous the tendencies of all these creatures have become. The men on Earth have not even spared the atmosphere of the air, which is the force of their life, for it's getting polluted day-by-day with the smokes and gases released by the chimneys and plants; he has not spared the forests which are important for their ecological balance; he has blocked the natural flow of rivers; the entire cycle of the Nature has been made topsy-turvy; and therefore, it is necessary to save this planet immediately, for all our efforts will be of no avail if further delay is caused. And, therefore, this planet cannot be saved unless it is totally vacated by the living creatures.”

Listening to all such views of his, rest of all became shocked. They had never thought that one of their colleagues would turn so violent and cruel, and advocate the policy of violence and cruelty, seeing the violence and cruelty infested the Earth. He was reacting against the situation in such a way as if the soul of the Earth had regenerated within him, and it (soul) was begging him for its life. His argument was so powerful that none had any

answer to it. He continued to say that it was necessary to pick up man from among other creatures of the Earth and just eliminate him.

For this, first of all, the radioactive pile of nuclear weapons will have to be defused, and certain special types of radio-waves will have to be constantly sent to eliminate the violent creatures from the Earth where other peace-loving creatures are also dwelling, or the biggest star near the Sun will have to be cast into the Sun. When so done, most powerful black spots with gravitation will appear which will remove the man from among other creatures of the Earth. The man's mind, being prone to violence and cruelty, will resist the gravitation as a part of its natural characteristic, and the electrical waves of his mind are bound to go out of control, and thus, the man will perish and the Earth will be liberated from the clutches of the cruel man, for ever.

Even if it is not done as suggested, the cruelly living creatures are bound to succumb to the Sun's gravitational force one day, because men on Earth are in the competitive race of gross violence and cruelty, and their minds have

become weak as well as unfit to the living laws of Nature, and all the electrical waves of their minds have lost the magnetic pull.

The same black spots are bound to eliminate the man from Earth. But, by that time, the entire Earth will lose its beauty and become the remains of ashes. It is because, by that time, the man will use all stock of explosives and the living Earth will land into the category of other planets which are now a desert bearing stones, dust and isolation. And, then this beautiful planet cannot be enlivened to its natural existence, whatever resources of knowledge be applied.

He asked his friends, “How can we convert the ashes of other creatures, trees and plants into seeds and children ? How will we separate the poison dissolved in seas and lakes? How can we clean the air round the Earth when we could not clean the air of our own world of origin even after thousands of years ? Remember, we have our own history of similar type which prohibited us from floating in the air for thousands of years, which curtailed our capacity of remaining awake from twenty-six-hours to just four-

hours, which changed the colour of our skin and allowed mere muscles to remain in the body in the name of bones. In fact, I do not want to see the repetition of the black history here on the beautiful Earth, the history which even changed the colour of our soil, I would never like to see it again, never, never, never,” and the tears rolled down from his eyes. He landed into a nostalgia.

The doctor tried to move towards him from his chair, but Huhi gestured at him for holding him to his seat, and said, “If you do not change your decision, and do not move forward to save this living planet, I will not stay here, I will move back and tell my people about this beautiful planet. I will persuade them to follow me and bring them here in order to save the beautiful planet from the destruction by liberating it from so violent and cruel creatures (men), so that the remaining lives might live as we do. But, till then I request you to bear the responsibility of saving this planet from any destruction caused by these violent creatures, for after all we all are lovers of Nature, and so it is your duty as well to save it. If your are with me, I tell you, we would be the custodian of a heaven-like beautiful Earth for

continuation of our civilization before our world of origin exploded or perished. Having acquired it, we can extend its life span to the double of its own, and we can make it more beautifully balanced, provided you attach your mission to this living earth. At least, we must change our decision keeping in view all our cultural interest linked to the Earth; perhaps our interest may be beneficial to the Earth. We have been lovers of living Nature and have known its entire cycle, and so there is no harm in becoming enemy of the unnaturally violent and cruel men folk, or else we will be doing injustice to our duty.

We must at least use our prudence to restore the rights of the Earth and re-establish them in the interest of those who deserve to possess them.” Completing his intention, Huhi glanced the Commander.

The Commander was looking little excited as Huhi’s observation posed a challenge to his prudence as well as his authoritative position. Presenting the counter arguments, he said, “Can we remain blameless after committing the massacre of such a large mankind on Earth ? How can we speak lies to ourselves ? You cannot realize that our

physical and mental ‘timelessness’ will be so badly affected that we may not survive at all. And, what will happen to those millions of scientists who, without being in contact with us, have supposed their world a rare phenomenon and are putting all efforts to protect it as they are worried about its death one day. And, think of thousands of years-long their efforts to break our impression of rarely being in the existence. Thus, it is our duty not to break their impression about us, not to merely waste away in our efforts to save others. Remember, the theory of ‘timelessness’ has been our saviour, and there can be no compromise with that.”

Upon hearing this, Huhi remarked, “We, without any trouble to prove blameless, can regain the ‘timelessness’ on the basis of our determined will-power, but we cannot regain this beautiful planet once it is lost of our hands.”

“Will-power does not have any solid physical base, for it keeps appearing and disappearing, and we can neither harm others by relying on it nor put us to any loss,” the Commander sharply quipped and adjourned the meeting temporarily for some time, quite wisely to find some time for himself as he had to take important decision and

announce it to his colleagues, among whom there were Huhi and the like-ones who had skeptic mind about the view-point of their mission whose success and failure depended on all of them.

They again gathered in the cabin of the Commander for arriving at a conclusion which was to acquire the final shape of their mission. Firm in the opinion and stern in his decision, the Commander said with serious tone, "I myself have not obtained permission of interference in the affairs of other living stars or planets, and therefore, to those colleagues with whom certain differences of opinion have cropped up, I cannot give permission to interfere with the affairs of the Earth. All possibilities which were created by Huhi are mere hypothetical and are nothing in the reality. Now, there is no room for any reconsideration of view-point, and all suppositions that were made by Huhi are out of the scope of our mission which we have brought from our world of origin. Remember, we are out to hunt for a living planet and its study, and if possible to maintain a friendship with the lives manifested. Of various facets of our mission, we have just touched upon is the discovery



part of it, while on the question of friendship we cannot right now take any decision, and let this option be kept open for the future, provided the life on the Earth should become in tune with us, lovers of Nature and Peace. As far as the third study is concerned, we will complete it unseen and unnoticed by the living creatures of the Earth, that is all, and I cannot give any such order which may directly or indirectly affect the lives on the Earth. In case some of the colleagues wished to seek any other orders, they might well return to their world of origin and obtain fresh orders for their mission. They shall be supplied the necessary means and equipment, provided that they should prove themselves perfect in the test of ‘timelessness’ once again. And, till that time, they shall be facilitated to undergo rigorous training of ‘timelessness’ in an inbuilt-laboratory of the satellite of the biggest star, the Jupiter.”

All this shattered the dreams of Huhi and his like-minded colleagues. However, they still did not lose hope, and became active in regaining their perfection in ‘timelessness’ with double the enthusiasm and

determination and entered the inbuilt-laboratory on Jupiter for training.

A matter of surprise was that one of the companions was also fully convinced with the views of Huhi and others, but he could not join them and thought it better to stay back with the Commander. He was very competent and had no amount of ego in himself. He being an able pilot had carved his significant role in the mission, and so he preferred being with the Commander in the interest of the mission.

In fact, the pilot knew well his duties towards the crew and the mission. He was younger in age than others, and his age could be a plus point in future during the return of the mission, because in the case of delay, others will have crossed their age limit.

However, the Commander was unaware of this young pilot's inclination towards the opinion of Huhi and his followers, or else he could have sent him back with them. There was one more reason for this, and that was the non-appearance of any effect of his disagreement on his health, perhaps his dilemma could not reach any stage of taking final decision.

The ten members of the team were undergoing the training of 'timelessness' at the centre created for them on Jupiter. Doctor was keeping a close watch on their training. Meanwhile, the Commander had also proposed to them that they could proceed to their predecided mission if they wished, but they refused his proposal by saying that they would better return to their world of origin in order to save their civilization and the beautiful living planet (Earth).

The commander wanted to utilize their disagreement by sending it from one corner of the globe to them through a continuing message, but he became disappointed, because they were determined to return to their world of origin, and necessary arrangements were provided. The Commander consoled himself by thinking that the return-mission would liberate their civilization from a great disbelief, under the headache of which they had been living for millions of years. He was sorry for the deplorable work which his colleagues had made their objective and deserted the mission. With this dilemma, the doctor continued his work.

Finally, all the ten companions including Huhi stood true to their test of 'timelessness.' The test was conducted by the Commander himself. Perhaps, it was an attempt to persuade them and remove from their mind the feelings of hatred for mankind. But, during this time also, they, without interfering with the 'timelessness' and without getting excited, kept arguing in favour of the Earth and the Nature. On that stage, there were two parties standing vis-a-vis. Both the parties were alluring him and trying to win his favour. One of the parties was his brain, which was representing all information gathered in it, while the other was his fickle mind which was full of contra-opinions, and

as it was like an unbridled horse, it could not be kept at one place under the control of the brain. That is why they were sitting like two opponents to each other.

His mind was tired and lacking enthusiasm, while the brain with the help of its knowledge was sitting abreast. But, the aim of the debate today was not to decide of defeat or victory, but to reach the destination with the help of the ultimate truth, where the soul could see the clear road to take the right decision.

In order to reach the decisive point, the nerveless mind collecting its entire force began the debate with loathsome voice and told the brain, “O Brain, you have made me tired...how you made me run across the futile world...I never loved that race, yet you made me search for it. Oh, all-knowing brain, despite knowing all about me and my fickleness, why did you not tie me to a fixed peg of search? Look, how much tired have you made me? I cannot get up now and the entire life now seems futile. How enthusiastic and hopeful I was ! But, you made me tired for the rest of the life. What was the need for searching the man while the entire Earth escaped from the man who was bent upon

turning it into the heap of ashes? The man was also bent upon poisoning the air which was his breath as well as that of other creatures. How can such a block-headed being adorn the Earth and cure its wounds ? The Nature which can save itself from the bloody claws can adorn itself as well. It will once again come back to its life and beauty in the absence of the violent and cruel race of mankind. It will soon remove its widely spread snow-coverings and become embellished with the greenery all over. And, in that situation, the presence of even a single man will prove detrimental to the Earth. I tell you, the Earth will be lucky enough to have no man at all on its surface. Now, the future of the living planet is safe against its enemies. Then, what is the need for searching at least one of the enemies?"

Listening to him patiently, the brain slowly spoke, "Oh Dear, you are my shadow, but you lack the smell of the knowledge that is within me, otherwise you would not have asked such a question to me. However, let me shed for you that nectar-like taste of knowledge, by receiving which you will also feel blessed with completion. You may ask me as many questions as you wish; I will make you

satisfied and doubtless so that you may not again commit the mistake of considering yourself distinct from me. Whatever I am going to tell you today will cause the last and the biggest event in you, for you will not be able to realize your own existence thereafter. So, listen to me carefully the bitter truth. The Earth, which you have been considering inanimate so far, is a gigantic living creature, that is to say, the entire Earth is a living body and has its characteristics which are bound by the laws of Nature, and whose cyclic process on the time scale is always uni-sided. All its actions and reactions are in the cyclic nature. In case any part of its action or reaction is disturbed or damaged, its cycle also gets disturbed or affected, and that action or reaction then becomes useless for the future and remains detached from the main body. However, the Earth being a living creature or body compensates its loss and re-acquires its natural cycling process, it recycles itself. The human race also being an important part of the natural cycle was then destroyed for ever, and the Earth, though capable of its own revival, would not be able to replace the destroyed component, the human being, with the suitable substitute,



because there was ( and also would be) no substitute to the human being on the Earth. It is not blessed with the faculty to invent the creature, like, human being, and so, it will have to repay for this loss by reducing in its age.”

The brain, listening to the mind, wanted to intercede but it was shocked to learn that the age of the Earth was linked to the mankind, and it became eager to know the cause of the linkage. He thought that he could not follow what the mind had said, and so it urged the mind to explain in detail the concept of linkage.

The mind needed some time to get energized to talk further, and so, both of them observed silence for a while. During the silence, the silence had to struggle against the noise. The silence however dominated over the noise. The entire open area also became a part of the prevailing silence. The milk-white moon was hanging over the head of the Pilot and its silver beams were showering on him through the foliage of Bunyan tree.

At the same time, the entire green plain was bathing in the silver shower of the moon, and the white looking giant flying saucer was resting in some corner like an old and

tired granny awaiting the Pilot's return. The entire nature was observing silence in the moon light, as if in meditation. The pilot was however at the centre of the silver silence, while the interaction between his mind and brain was on.

Gradually raising the voice, the brain said to the mind, "Oh Mind, in order to understand this, you have to know about origin of the Solar family so that you may be able to estimate about its life. Listen carefully to what I am going to tell you. It is a story of pre-Solar family era. To believe it you will have to rely on certain exceptions as well. One of them is, a tremendously powerful mass of gravitational pull, which is situated at a fixed state in the Space. The immovability of this mass is an exception in this moving universe. Such a huge mass of gravitational pull develops after complete explosion of our star whose most of the fuel stock gets converted into energy. However, the left over element does not easily get converted into energy. In such a situation, the pressure of energy required for the motion outside increases manifold in a second, creating a huge mass of gravitational pull therein. But in this gravitational pull, there is yet a particle in the suddenly changing

element which is always situated at centre of the star, and that particle escapes this process, and it becomes successful in coming out of the huge mass. We call it the instant particle ( tat kan ).”

According to him, there is a specific reason for the star to be safe from such explosion because that particle does not interact with the physical world in any way, and it does not produce any amount of gravitational pull around it in order to keep itself in the motion. It is due to this reason, that particle is the hardest particle in the Cosmos. That particle cannot get worn out and cannot be broken further by any action or process, while on the other hand, all other particles or waves are required to generate the required amount of gravitational pull in order to remain active or in motion.

In other words, other particles or elements have to pass through the gravitational pull, and therefore, there is a gradual wearing out for them. In this way, the existence also determines its own life span. The instant particle (tat kan ) however has an exception, and it gets escaped from the explosions of the stars.

The instant particle is not influenced by the physical laws, and thus remaining in the existence, on the contrary it also has the capability of influencing the physical laws. This is the only particle violating every law in the physical world. Any Sun or Solar family comes into existence on the basis of gravitational pull and instant particle ( tat kan ), but for this purpose the huge mass of gravitational pull must be in a special shape, possessing the capability to formation of Solar family, so that whenever it passed through the process of re-generation, it should provide a Solar family.

The instant particle (tat kan ) after its safe come out immediately after the explosion in the star leaves for its infinite journey. During the journey, when it comes across the mass of gravitational pull, it, without being affected by the mass, pierces the mass and moves ahead.

Then, its piercing through the mass activates the force of gravitational pull, and then it draws up in a circular formation. Then, the instant particle ( tat kan ) keeps on piercing the mass within with certain speed of the force, but at the same time, the entire gravitational pull drawing up

towards the particle with more speed or force than that during the piercing process tries to exercise its own force.

As soon as the pressure becomes more than the requirement, the entire pressure of the gravitational pull, ranging right from the instant particle (tat kan ) to that point of maximum pressure of the mass of gravitational pull, changes into a matter or material.

This moment of time is the moment of creation, coincidence and meeting of anything when at the same moment, at the same place and in the same mass several phenomena take place. When the gravitational pull tries to exercise its more than the required force on the instant particle (tat kan ), the total gravitational pull of the mass becomes active and draws up in a circular formation to the instant particle, and then the total gravitational pressure gets changed into the matter which in itself is a pure energy.

But, the transformation of gravitational pull into pure energy is to that extent when the force keeps exercising beyond the limit of the requirement, and at the same time the energy-mass with speed keeps moving towards that

point where the remaining gravitational pull is in greater quantity.

As the pure energy, because of being attracted by its natural primary pressure, starts moving towards the centre, the form of the pure energy, due to travelling a distance, keeps changing into the complexity of the matter. After seconds, the large part of the energy loaded with complexity of the matter might have changed into a strong shield (coverage) around the instant particle (tat kan), and small part, because of being in maximum distance and also being in the state of loose coverage, must not have reached there and must have got struck with the harder and larger coverage (crust), and the pressure that was coming towards the centre (nucleus) must have got blocked up.

This being the situation, the entire force of the loose coverage must have changed to opposite direction, it must have got thrown up afar in the form of a half-moon in the dark Space. It is possible that a central force must have got built up at several points in its half-moon form; it must have got broken into several parts, stars and satellites, etc, all due to opposite pull. At the end of this coverage, several

comets must have got formed, and in this way, the solar family must have come into existence soon after formation of the Sun.

In the beginning, the ball of fire must be appearing dark on one side because then it must be possessing the left over gravitational pull in greater quantity and in its natural form, and which must have remained as it is because of not being in the state of pressure. The new mass, because of these reasons, must be possessing dark on one side, and it must have kept itself moving on its axis that very side, while on the other side wherein the gravitational pull coverage was loose, the rays must have shot up for the first time, and perhaps the Sun must have witnessed its place of origin, moving backward.

In this way, the Sun must have got out of the dark womb and started moving freely in the Space. In fact, the constructive part of the Sun or the solar family remained in the dark, completing its half of the construction in the dark, and it perhaps always functioned in the same dark system. As soon as the total gravitational pull changed into the purest form of energy, the energy, because of travelling a

long distance, started changing into various other complex forms of the matter, and it got changed into hardness due to formation of the crust.

But, such a changing phenomenon was not the same with the Sun and its solar family. It is because both the changes underwent a very great difference which remained as it is. On one hand, the entire matter of the Sun, right from its nucleus towards the crust, changed in to hardness and stability. On the other hand, the same matter in the members of the solar family, including the planets and satellites, started changing into hardness and stability, right from their crust towards the nucleus. Its sole cause is the circumstantial situation around them.

The gravitational pull which was left over in a large quantity helped the new matter cool down at the nucleus, before they could get united. It must have happened so because the Sun for its motion must not have needed the required gravitational pull from within, perhaps it must have easily got the required gravitational pull on the way. It is because of this, the matters around the nucleus in the Sun must have become inactive and thus cooled down. And, the



moment the left over gravitational pull must have got exhausted, the Sun must have started gathering the needed gravitational pull from the hottest layer of the outer coverage (crust), and kept it always active, and which it has been doing time-to-time by changing the matter of outer coverage into energy. In this way, the outer crust of the Sun remained very hot and acted as its very sensitive and complex brain.

In this way, the hardness of matter of the Sun from inside towards outside must have started receding, and on the basis of the activeness of its total matter, both types of its motion must have also receded, and in the long, its motions must have come to stable situation. The Sun the nucleus, slipped down below the freezing point. Isn't it a matter of great surprise? At one place, the temperature is at the highest point on the out cover while the same is below freezing point in the inner part, the nucleus!!”

The brain, breaking the concentration of the mind for a while again asked, “Aren't you astonished even a bit?”

Breaking its own seriousness, the mind now attacked the brain, saying, “I feel, you are still in doubt about your

knowledge, but worry not, I fully agree with your reasoning, please do not leave me in the midway, complete your talk. You always kept the knowledge of the Cosmos concealed from me. I am really sad, you always considered me a stranger.”

When heard the word ‘doubt’, the brain landed into the state of dilemma. It could not understand the talks of the mind, but in few seconds, recognizing the integrity of the mind, it spoke out -- “It appeared to me that you would not believe as to how the matter in the nucleus was below the freezing point when the temperature on crust or outer cover was highest. You must be very surprised over these two contrasting situations. Under this pretext, I tried to seek your support for my knowledge, but you gave it to me in a round-about-manner. What I meant was that the nucleus must be situated at a place whose temperature was even below the freezing point. If supposed that the temperature on the crust and the nucleus was the same, then the linear or uni-directional speed of the Sun should be near the speed of light, which is not, and that is why the temperature at the nucleus of the Sun must be even below freezing point.

The inner place of each stable & balanced star produces entirely different matter which do not resemble with the matter-world. The matter loses its own matters tic character get change into non nucleus. non-atomic structural matter. It is another kind of fusion of matter world without radiating energy. It changes into permanent stable & in non breakable form. We called it TATKAN i.e. the matter of soul or dark-matter.

The long lasting balanced sun convert its at least ten percent of total mass into the dark matter. The coolest form of matter which is near to convert into dark matter complete its remaining journey of change through the life of living being. Such a incomplete dark matter get shelter of living world to fulfil its stability. Its incompleteness generate some effininty towards living world to complete its journey of stability to be fulfilled.

Oh Mind, but the same fact is proved quite opposite in respect of the planets and satellites of the Solar family. During the first phase of the birth of the Sun, the members of entire solar family, for their motion, got the required gravitational pull directly from the Sun, and of course they must have derived some gravitational pull even from their own crust, for quite a long time. Though they received gravitational pull from the Sun, the pressure of gravitational pull like that of the Sun was not formed, and that is why the outer covering of all the planets and satellites started changing into hard matter, but such a process must not have continued for a long time, yet this process must have done something great due to which the

outer covering (crust) of these planets and stars must have started cooling down, and they must have turned into solid objects. This process must have been continuing even after the exhaustion of left over gravitational pull. Till then, there must have been some similarity between their formation and that of the Sun-matters. As this similarity must have started changing into dissimilarity, all the planets must have become self-dependent for the gravitational pull required for their individual motion. It is possible that they must have depended on the activation in their nucleus because of delay in the use of outer covering. They must have changed the active matter into a little energy and thus created the gravitational pull. This is the reason that the nucleus of all the planets and stars remained always more active than the outer sphere of the Sun, and that is still working like the Sun as highly sensitive and complex as well as an alert brain. But, the constant use made the inner circumference of active temperature reduced and started cooling down, resulting into development of the shape of the planets and stars.

In this way, the outer sphere of the solar family started going towards zero temperature and the nucleus towards high temperature. The radioactive matters helped in the process of maintaining the temperature. But, as the radiation constantly keeps percolating towards the nucleus and that is why this part is hotter than the outer sphere of the Sun. These radioactive matters with their emanated rays keep the nucleus always hot at the required temperature and keep fulfilling the need of gravitational pull outside. In this way, a bigger part of the nucleus of the Earth remained hot like the Sun, and which worked as an accurate and alert brain for the Earth. That is why the Earth and other planets and stars became self-controlled masses.” It continued to say, “But, now in the journey ahead, the Earth, distributing its need of gravitational pull to the resources of its outer covering, and completely detaching itself from other planets, is getting self-controlled by itself. Gradually, the dust particles, air Sun-light of all barren planets changed into gravitational pull and started helping their liquid central brain. And, therefore, the temperature of their nucleus remained stable for a long time. The Earth, on the

other hand, rather than changing its soil into dry dust and air, gave birth to a vast world of creatures, animate and inanimate things. It extracted more work from the world of creatures, in comparison to the dust, and maintained its inner temperature greater than that of the Sun, and kept the sensitivity and activity of its inner temperature updated, which is found even today. The half wheel of its nature is connected from here only, which you could not see, and the story of its life and liveliness begins from here. When other planets were receiving their gravitational pull from their nucleus and also from the dust of their crust as well as the air in order to maintain their motion, the behaviour of the Earth then was quite different from them. When the crust of the Earth had completely cooled down and all matters had started appearing in their real forms, the Earth since then had started distributing its need of gravitational pull to its various resources; it derived support from them and reduced its dependence on the matter in hot liquid form gathered in its inner sphere, the nucleus. In this venture, the liquid wealth, the water, spread on its crust helped it first of all. The special molecular construction of water receiving

energy from the Sun directly changed it into maximum gravitational pull, and stocked the same for the Earth as an additional requirement and kept it emanating. The dependency of the energy on the centre, the nucleus, then started reducing, and the pressure too disappeared. As a result, the explosion or the decentralization of matters in the nucleus stopped, and the temperature remained stable. Gradually, when the temperature remained constant for a long time, the water started assisting in the creation of life on the earth. For such a charismatic phenomenon, the momentary stability in the temperature must have played a vital role, bringing stability in the wavering magnetic waves too. Earlier, several elements dissolved in the water got mixed up and also became separated due to their wavering characteristics, and making changes in the formation of chemicals dissolved in it. But, during the stationary moment and stable temperature, some such changes must have occurred in the chemical structure of certain minerals dissolved in the water, or even in a drop of it, or even in the most minute part of it, that such structure must have been capable of creating maximum gravitational



energy from the energy it received from the Sun. In this way, its structure must have remained in existence for some time and attempts to create similar structures must have been successful in procuring the same minerals nearby. It must have tied itself to the characteristic of such created gravitational energy and made the friendship more sustainable and helped in maintaining its shape and structure as before. In this way, the Earth developed in the field of procuring additional gravitational pull by constituting an easy mechanism. But, then, not even one characteristic of very simple and subtle creature must have been present in that constitution. It must have then, depending on its sphere and creating gravitational energy in more quantity, must have bound itself to that constitution, and there it must have produced similar constitution and broken it into pieces which must have increased in their number. The nucleus of the Earth must have always changed its heat into additional quantity of gravitational pull in order to struggle against Sun's

gravitational cyclone that came on definite time, and the useless matter must have remained in more quantity in its nucleus, forcing the earth to swell in less span of time, and affecting every time directly or indirectly the world of creatures on it. Such a cyclone must have changed various phases of the weather, even time of day and night must have increased a little. It is because of such big cyclones of the Sun, the Earth must have suddenly expanded and new portions of land must have projected upward from the seas and oceans, and deep cracks too must have developed in the bottoms of the seas and oceans. Hot lava must have seeped out to cement those cracks. It must have joined the cracks from the beginning, but at the same time the boiling water must have harmed the water creatures in great quantity. The lives in the water must have got the projected lands in the seas and oceans, what we call islands, and there they must have settled their new life on them. They must have then become manifold in their population. In this way, the life cycle on the Earth must have come into motion, but whether the same cycle would continue in future or not cannot be predicted.”

Hearing this, the seriousness of the mind suddenly broke and it became startled for a while and expressing its anger, it said, “Why do you utter the words of doubt when you feel that the utterance of truth is under your command. I cannot allow you today to speak the words of doubt. Perhaps, under this pretext, you want to hide something. But, do not hide anything today at least from me; keep quenching the thirst of my knowledge. I want to be one with you. I want to lose my every thing in you. Therefore, if you have brought me to the present moment, tell me the future of this life-giving Earth.”

The brain then kept quiet for a while and landed into introspection. In this way, it realized the entire nature, shivered with the blowing cold air and heard the silent music around him. Experiencing its deep heart beats, it then told the mind, “O Mind, the Earth till today kept cooling slowly as usual, kept expanding, kept becoming as fat as it can, yet it kept its geo-centric temperature more than that of the Sun ! It also made it highly sensitive to any gravitational friction from outside. It kept it more active than the alert brain, more capable. It is seen from the agility

of its magnetic waves. But, the Earth, passing through a long journey of its life, is heading towards the old age and also becoming weak. Now, its dependency is more on the creatures living on it, and perhaps the life on the Earth will generate additional gravitational pull for it and act as its crutches, but this too has a limit. It will be helpless when the congenial environment is not available to it. In the time to come, the weakness of the Earth will not be able to provide that environment which it has always been giving till now. It is because the geo-centric sphere of the Earth maintains its highest temperature due to those radioactive matters which are scattered around it, and whose radiation always percolates inward. This will help the geo-centric sphere of the Earth to maintain its heat. But, as it started expanding, becoming fat, it started distancing from the radioactive matters and there came a recession in its special impact. Now, it cannot, in close contact with its nucleus, help itself. Moreover, all matters due to constant percolation of the radiation must have changed into stable and balanced matters. Its radioactive matters because of both the reasons will not be able to keep the geo-centric

sphere hot. Similarly, there will be reduction in the explosive matter found in the liquid matter in its geocentric sphere, as per the need outside. Due to all this, there will be slight corresponding reduction in the temperature of geocentric sphere after forty five thousand years, and in the coming seventy to eighty billion years the high temperature of its geo-centre will turn inactive and cold. But, before that, all creatures on the Earth will perish in forty five billion years from now. Its reason is linked to the same aging factor. The end of life on Earth will also be due to its becoming fatter. Such a condition of the swelling of the Earth will come after four or five in number, small or big gravitational storms arising from the Sun.
